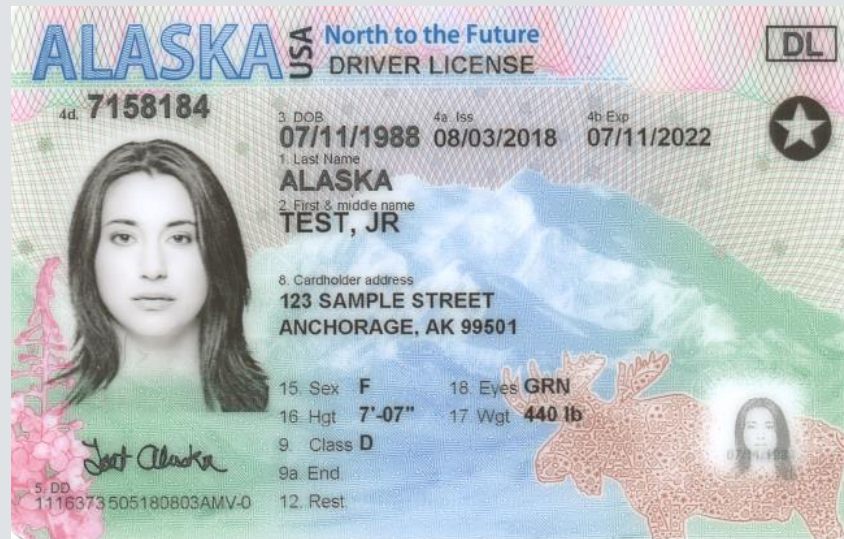

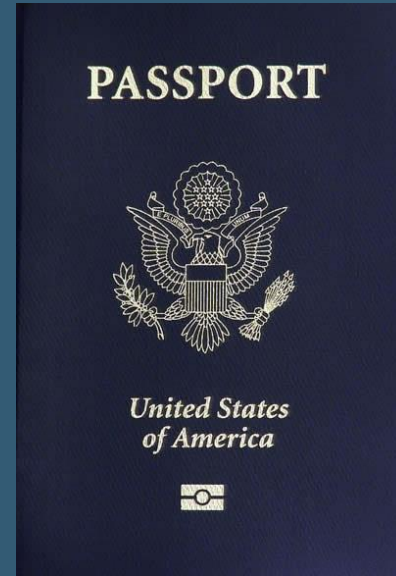
REAL ID Act

- Passed by Congress in 2005
- Established minimum security standards for state-issued driver's licenses and identification cards
- Restricts access to:
 - Commercial aircrafts
 - Federal facilities
- October 1, 2020 enforcement date



Documents Needed

1. Identity & Lawful Status
 - Birth Certificate or Passport
 2. Social Security Number
 - SS Card, W2 or 1099
 3. Proof of Residential Address
 - Recent mail, utility bills, lease agreements, letter from employer, etc.
 - Physical address only, no PO boxes
 4. Name Change Documents
 - Marriage certificates, divorce decrees, etc.

Alternatives to REAL ID

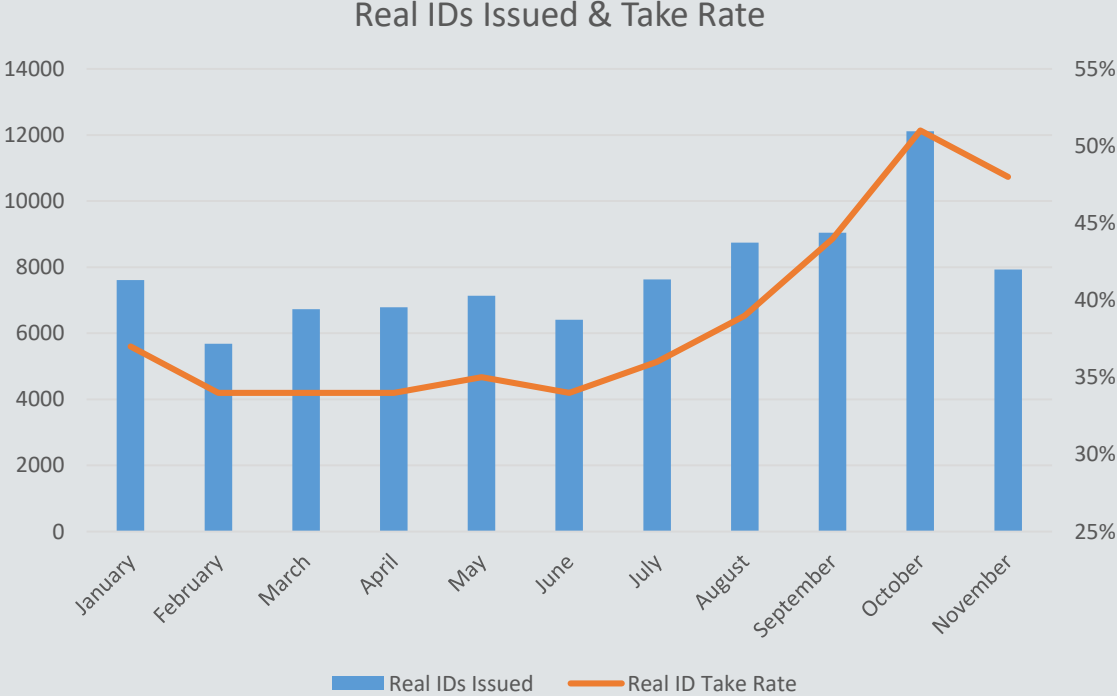
IDs that fly.

Acceptable forms of ID for air travel include:

- REAL ID driver's license or other REAL ID compliant state photo identity card issued by Department of Motor Vehicles (or equivalent)
- U.S. passport
- U.S. passport card
- DHS trusted traveler card (Global Entry, NEXUS, SENTRI, FAST)
- U.S. Department of Defense ID, including IDs issued to dependents
- Permanent resident card
- Border crossing card
- DHS-designated enhanced driver's license
- Federally recognized, tribal-issued photo ID
- HSPD-12 PIV card
- Foreign government-issued passport
- Canadian provincial driver's license or Indian and Northern Affairs Canada card
- Transportation worker identification credential (TWIC®)
- U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services Employment Authorization Card (I-766)
- U.S. Merchant Mariner Credential

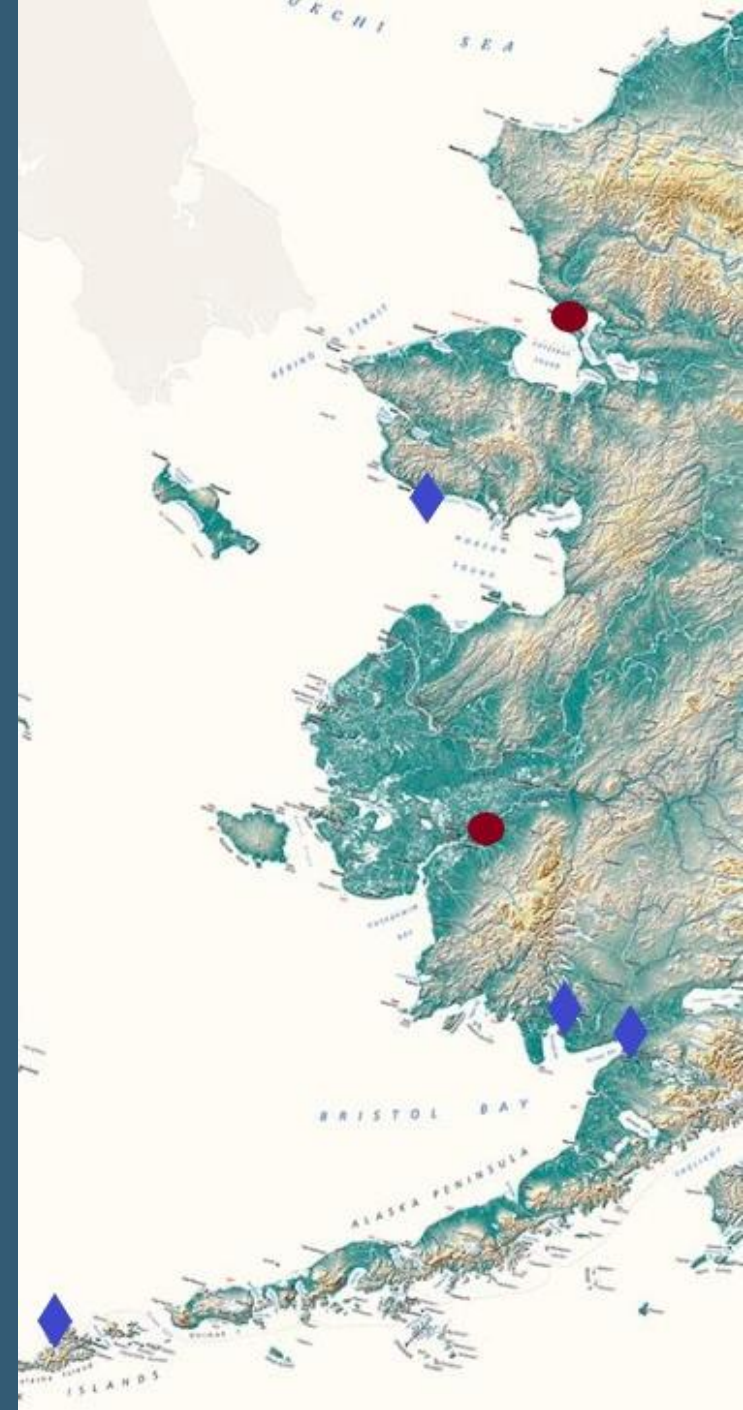
Alaska's Status

- Passed legislation allowing us to issue REAL IDs
- Began issuing REAL IDs in January, 2019
- Received compliance status from DHS
- YTD Issued 85K Cards with a 50% take rate



DMV Support in Rural Alaska

- Began outreach to local Native Corporations and organizations
- Preparing for 2020 trips
- DMV responsible for equipment and employee(s)
- Community responsible for travel and providing capable IT connectivity
 - *Flights, Lodging, Shipping and Per Diem*

REAL ID Enforcement Begins October 1st, 2020

- Changes requirements to fly domestically and access federal facilities
